Sealed bids will be received by the Morrison County Historical Society (MCHS), Little Falls, Minnesota at the Morrison County Soil and Water Conservation District, 16776 Heron Rd #6580, Little Falls, Minnesota, 56345, until 12:00 p.m., March 17, 2025, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud for furnishing all labor, materials, and all else necessary for the construction of the **Mississippi River Stream-bank Restoration Project, Little Falls, Minnesota**. The bid opening will also be available at the same date and time via **Microsoft Teams video conference: meeting ID 298 752 508 102, passcode AZ67xP9l**.

All bidders must be able to submit a sworn statement to the Morrison County Historical Society demonstrating that it is a responsible contractor as defined by Minnesota Statute 16C.285. The failure to provide such a statement will render any proposal non-responsive.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a bidder's security in a sum equal to ten (10) percent of the full amount of the bid. The bidder may submit a Bid Bond, certified check, or cashier's check payable to the Morrison County Historical Society. The bid security is a guarantee that the bidder, if awarded the contract, will enter into a contract for the work described in the Contract Documents. The bid security of the three (3) lowest bidders will be retained until the contract has been awarded and executed, but no longer than sixty (60) days after the opening of bids. The successful bidder will be required to furnish contract Performance and Payment Bonds, each in the full amount of the contract.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities. Complete Instructions for filing bids are included in the Instructions to Bidders.
